

..there seems to be distinct periods that God uses to profoundly impact a wide range of people. One of these is the East African Revival that permeated East Africa between the late 1920s and 1930s. A few years ago I was privileged to attend a celebration of revival movement at its birthplace in Gahini, Rwanda. Throughout the celebration, speakers mentioned famous and influential African leaders who had been impacted by the revival and one of those was the Ugandan Anglican martyr Archbishop Janani Luwum (1922-1977).



Pope John XXIII

John XXIII (1881-1963) was pope from 1958 to 1963. He convoked the Second Vatican Council, thus launching a renewal in the Roman Catholic Church and inaugurating a new era in its history.

Much of this significance stemmed, naturally, from the train of events which he set in motion during the 5 years of his reign, but much of it also lay in his unique personality. Previous popes had usually been remote and austere figures; from the very outset John endeared himself to the whole world by his warmth, humor, and easy approachability. He had an impatience with empty traditionalism and often astonished his aides by the forthright way in which he cut through meaningless formalities.

Evelyn Underhill (1875-1941)

She is commemorated in our liturgical calendar on the day she died, 15 June. Thirty-five years after her death, Michael Ramsay, the then Archbishop of Canterbury, reminded members of the Church of England that this amazing woman was still relevant, and profoundly worthy of her reputation in her own time as a scholar, a teacher, a writer, and a mystic:

"She did much to extend the tradition of 'spiritual direction' which elicits people's own spiritual capacities and helps them find themselves in paths of freedom...She was able to use the insights...from her own studies for the expression of theology and spirituality of a distinctively Anglican kind. Few in modern times have done more to show the theological foundations of the life of prayer and to witness to the inter-penetration of prayer and theology. She has a place of her own, and it is an important one." (Allchin & Ramsay, 1977, p.22).

Moved to one bay of the North Transept of the present Cathedral

1906

Mechanical organ coupled to pneumatic organ and enlarged to an extra 13 stops by the original builder. Occupied 2 bays of the North Transept.

1956
-57

Mr. Noel Ferguson, an optometrist from Cairns, rebuilt it with twenty-two speaking stops and the action was changed from mechanical to electro-pneumatic to stop the delay that occurred between the two.



The Kennedys have recently visited Coventry Cathedral and met with the Chair of the Friends of the Coventry Cathedral. He was very interested in hearing our story. No one knows the whereabouts of the original Foundation Stone. There does not even seem to be a photo.





THE NORTH QUEENSLAND OPENING OF SYNOD.

The twenty-eighth Synod of the Diocese of North Queensland opened in the Synod Hall at Townsville on Thursday afternoon. In the absence of the Bishop of North Queensland, through Illness, Ven. Archdeacon Thomas presided and read the inaugural address. There was a large attendance of the clergy from different parts, of the diocese and a fair attendance of lay representatives.”

A letter was read from Bishop Feetham who was recovering from an operation in St Martin’s Hospital in Brisbane

.....Cathedral Rood: The erection of the rood In which the Bishop took a great interest has been accomplished, and doubtless we are agreed that It is the most beautiful piece of work we have in North Queensland. We still need contributions from relatives and friends of deceased soldiers.
