## ABOUT ST JOHN AMBULANCE

St John Ambulance is dedicated to the teaching and practice of medical first aid and the provision of ambulance and community volunteer services, all of which derive their origins from the St John Ambulance Association founded in 1877 in the United Kingdom.

The active uniformed first-aiders known as the St John Ambulance Brigade or Community Services were introduced in 1887.

There are now more than 500,000 such volunteers worldwide, and eleven operating priorities.



- ◆ 10 July 1877 St John Ambulance Association formed to teach first-aid in large railway centres and mining districts.
- ◆ June 1887 St John Ambulance Brigade is formed as a uniformed organisation to provide a First Aid and Ambulance services at public events.
- ◆ 14 May 1888 British Order of St John is granted royal charter by Queen Victoria.
- ◆ 1974 The St John Ambulance Association and The St John Ambulance Brigade were amalgamated to form the present St John Ambulance Foundation.
- ◆ 1999 The Order of St John celebrated its 900th anniversary worldwide.

St John Ambulance would like to thank the Diocesan Bishop, the Dean and Congregation of St James' Cathedral Parish for their hospitality; and to the Mission to Seafarers for its assistance in the organisation of this Service and Refreshments.



The St. John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group is the charitable foundation which operates an ophthalmic hospital in Jerusalem and satellite eye care clinics in the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Hospital Group is based in Jerusalem and is the main provider of eye care in the Palestinian territories. Patients receive care regardless of ethnicity, religion or ability to pay.

The original St John Ophthalmic Hospital opened by The Order of St John in 1882 on the Bethlehem Road just south of the old city of Jerusalem.

Between 1949 and 1960 the hospital operated from two houses owned by the Order in Muristan Street in the old city of Jerusalem, and where a commemorative inscription can be read to this day.

The hospital's present building was opened in 1960 at Nashashibi Street in Sheikh Jarrah.

The St John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group is today the only charitable provider of eye care in Gaza, the West Bank, including East Jerusalem, where rates of blindness are ten times higher than in the West.

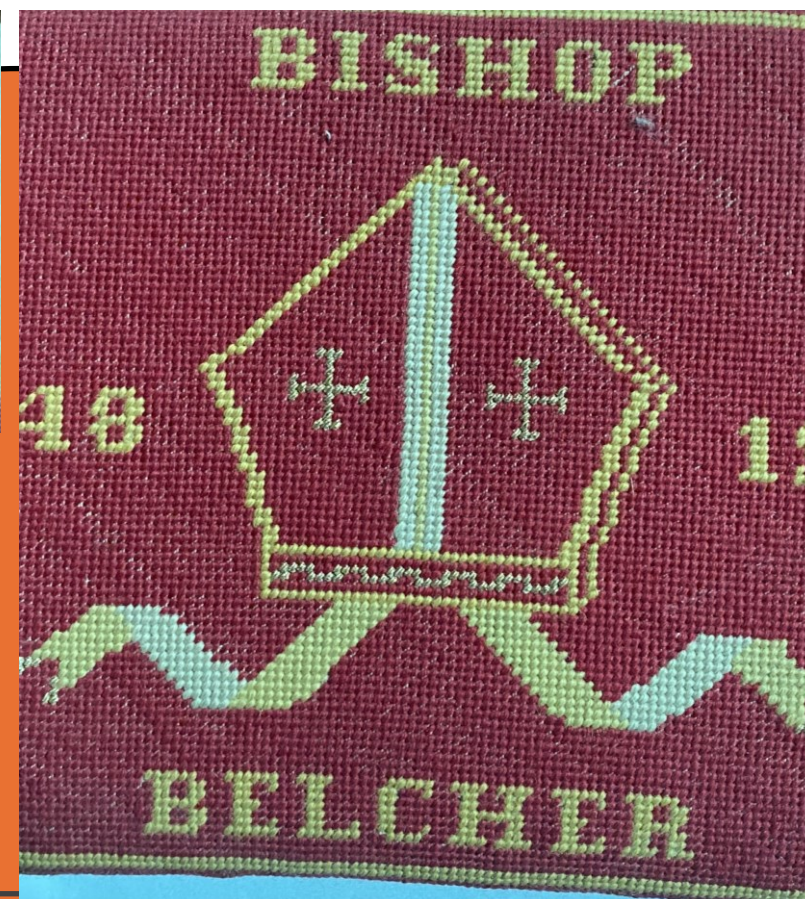

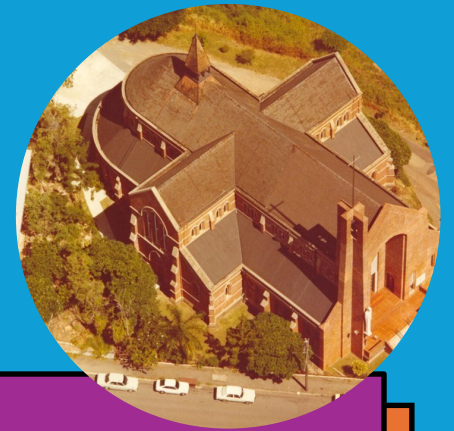

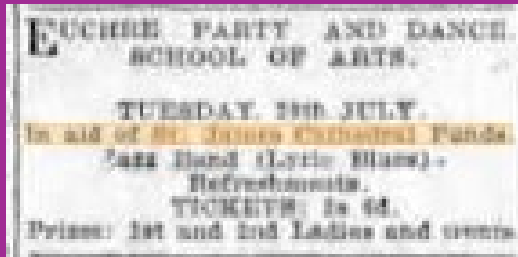

## THE NORTH QUEENSLAND OPENING OF SYNOD.

The twenty-eighth Synod of the Diocese of North Queensland opened in the Synod Hall at Townsville on Thursday afternoon. In the absence of the Bishop of North Queensland, through illness, Ven. Archdeacon Thomas presided and read the inaugural address. There was a large attendance of the clergy from different parts, of the diocese and a fair attendance of lay representatives.”

A letter was read from Bishop Feetham who was recovering from an operation in St Martin’s Hospital in Brisbane

.....Cathedral Rood: The erection of the rood In which the Bishop took great an interest has been accomplished, and doubtless we are agreed that It is the most beautiful piece of work we have in North Queensland. We still need contributions from relatives and friends of deceased soldiers.
